Radlett were winners of the Herts County Junior cup competition. Over the summer, we will be running one team in the Herts league with Gavin Green captaining. It was great to see some new names playing for the teams over the winter and we would like to encourage more members to participate and run Club teams. Finally, the Club have again been asked to host the Herts Closed tournament in late September which is a great honour.

The Racketball ladder is in place and a Racketball event will be planned for early autumn.

The Junior activities at the Club continue to be well run by Julian Craxton. This season the results were that

- 6 graded tournaments helped raise £898 for C.R.Y. (Cardiac Risk in the Young) (over £8,000 raised over the years)
- 6 juniors were selected for U13/15/17/19 Herts county teams this season
- 12 juniors are currently ranked in the top 6 of their Herts age groups.
- Radlett has won all 6 Herts inter-club leagues this season...U11 div 1 and div 2, U13 div 1, U19 div 1, div 2 and div 3...the first time ever.

This has taken its toll so the squash court maintenance has been scheduled for June. The front-wall tins need to be replaced, quotes are being obtained and potential for advertising income to be followed-up.
