

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

As a general guide to emergency action to be taken where there is serious or imminent danger, the Club has implemented the following basic procedures:

ACTION IN THE EVENT OF FIRE

IF YOU DISCOVER A FIRE:

- Close all doors to the room.
- Break the glass of the nearest fire alarm call point.
- Dial 999 or 112 and give details to the Emergency Services:

- Before opening closed doors check them for heat, which may indicate a fire behind the door.
- Leave the building and go to the nearest assembly point (Front of Building – Car Park alongside Tennis Court 11) (Rear of Building - Tennis Court 4).
- You may tackle the fire with an extinguisher or fire blanket but only if you have been trained in fire prevention and it is safe to do so.

IF YOU HEAR THE FIRE ALARM:

Close all doors to the room.

Leave the building via the nearest exit (following the Fire Exit signs) and go to the assembly point (Front of Building – Car Park alongside Tennis Court 11, Rear of Building - Tennis Court 4).

IMPORTANT:

- Do not stop to collect belongings.
- Do not re-enter the building until the Fire Service has declared it safe to do so.
